

COUNCIL MINUTES
APRIL 12, 2016

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONDOVI MET IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF CITY HALL FOR THEIR FIRST MEETING OF THE MONTH. MAYOR TREIG PRONSCHINSKE PRESIDED OVER THE MEETING WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

A PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD REGARDING OPENING CITY STREETS TO ATV/UTV USE. COMMENTS WERE SHARED FROM SEVERAL CITY RESIDENTS ON THIS ISSUE. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JOHNSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN LUBINSKY TO CLOSE THE PUBLIC HEARING ON OPENING CITY STREETS TO ATV/UTV USE. MOTION CARRIED.

THE COUNCIL MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR TREIG PRONSCHINSKE AT 6:55 P.M.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN LUBINSKY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HOLDEN TO ACCEPT THE AGENDA AS POSTED. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN KRISIK AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN RUD TO APPROVE THE MARCH 22, 2016 COUNCIL MINUTES. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HOLDEN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN RUD TO ADOPT ORDINANCE CHAPTER 7B AS PRESENTED THAT WOULD OPEN ALL CITY STREETS TO ATV/UTV USE WITH A CURFEW OF 10:00 P.M. AND AMEND SPEED LIMIT TO 10 MPH. THIS WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE AFTER ALL SIGNS ARE POSTED. MOTION CARRIED WITH COUNCILWOMAN SMITH, COUNCILMAN KRISIK AND COUNCILWOMAN LARSON VOTING NO.

NO UPDATE WAS AVAILABLE FROM PLUNKETT'S PEST CONTROL ON PIGEON PROBLEM. BRENDA GRUBER SHARED HER IDEA AND DAN LAUERSDORF SHARED THAT HE HAS NOT RECEIVED INFORMATION BACK ON AN ALTERNATIVE SPRAY OPTION.
