

## COUNCIL MINUTES

JULY 12, 2016

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONDOVI MET IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF CITY HALL FOR THEIR FIRST MEETING OF THE MONTH. MAYOR TREIG PRONSCHINSKE PRESIDED OVER THE MEETING WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILWOMAN SMITH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN RUD TO ACCEPT THE AGENDA AS POSTED. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILWOMAN LARSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN KRISIK TO APPROVE THE JUNE 28, 2016 COUNCIL MINUTES WITH THE CORRECTIONS OF ADDING "IF THE EMPLOYEES ANNIVERSARY DATE HAS PAST" AFTER "PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS WITH ALL SUPERVISORS COMPLETING THEM BY OCTOBER 1, 2016" (PAR. 5) AND "WIPPLI" SHOULD BE "WIPFLI" (PAR. 7). MOTION CARRIED.

### CITIZENS COMMENTS:

BRYAN GIBBS, PROPERTY MANAGER OF SCHAFER PROPERTIES, SHARED INFORMATION REGARDING THE CLOTHING BOX LOCATED ON THE SCHAFER PROPERTY WHICH IS A TOPIC ALSO LISTED AS AN AGENDA ITEM.

CAROL RISLER, TREAS. OF THE BUFFALO COUNTY TRAIL RIDERS, SHARED HER CLARIFICATION THAT THE ATV/UTV APPROVAL PROCESS HAS BEEN 8 MONTHS.

LAURIE JOHNSTON, RESIDENT, MENTIONED THE NUMBER OF GEESE ON AND AROUND MIRROR LAKE AND THE MESS THEY ARE LEAVING IN OUR PARKS AND ON THE SIDEWALKS.

LORI WHELAN, RESIDENT, ASKED THE COUNCIL TO KEEP THE SAFETY OF CITY RESIDENTS IN MIND WHEN VOTING ON ATV/UTV MATTERS.

ROGER RISLER, PRESIDENT OF THE BUFFALO COUNTY TRAIL RIDERS, SHARED HIS CLARIFICATION THAT THE "ALL OR NOTHING" IN OPENING THE CITY STREETS TO ATV/UTV USE WAS SO ALL RESIDENTS COULD GET TO THE TRAIL.

CONNIE MATCHEY, SECRETARY OF THE BUFFALO COUNTY TRAIL RIDERS, SHARED HER THOUGHTS ON THE ATV/UTV INCIDENTS MENTIONED AT THE 6/28/16 COUNCIL MEETING AND THE CONNECTION TO MISUNDERSTANDING THE RULES.

ARLEEN PRISSEL, RESIDENT, ASKED QUESTIONS THAT LEAD TO CONCERN THAT ATV/UTV OPERATORS DO NOT NEED A LICENSE AND THE LACK OF RECOURSE IF THEY ARE NOT INSURED. ALSO QUESTIONED WHAT THE SIGNS ON EVERY CORNER DO FOR THE BEAUTY OF OUR CITY.

LORI FALKNER, RESIDENT, ASKED A QUESTION THAT FOUND THE CITY WOULD NOT HAVE LIABILITY IF AN UNINSURED OPERATOR OF ATV/UTV WAS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT IN THE CITY.

CHAD CLARK, RESIDENT, ALSO DISCUSSED SIGNAGE AROUND TOWER LANE.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR, DAN LAUERSDORF, SHARED INFORMATION HE HAS PUT TOGETHER ON THE CHRISTOPHER REEVES GRANT APPLICATION SO FAR, STATING HE IS LOOKING FOR LETTERS

OF SUPPORT FOR THE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT. COUNCIL WOULD LIKE TO REVIEW THE APPLICATION AGAIN AS AN AGENDA ITEM FOR THE 7/26/2016 COUNCIL MEETING.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN KRISIK AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN SCHULTZ TO AMEND THE PROPOSED ATV/UTV ORDINANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING THREE UPDATES:

- (1) SECTION 7B.02 ATV/UTV TRAILS AND ROUTES DESIGNATED (3) NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE ... IN ANY PARK (EXCEPT ON SHARPS POINT PARK ROAD AND PARKING LOT AND THE JOSEPH I. PETERSON RECREATIONAL PARK AND ARBORETUM PARKING LOT)...
- (2) ROUTES: THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THEIR ENTIRETY TO INCLUDE: (POEDEN PLACE)
- (3) SECTION 7B.04 ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS (2) THE ATV/UTV CLUB (BUFFALO COUNTY TRAIL RIDERS) SHALL PAY THE COST OF ... MOTION CARRIED WITH COUNCILWOMAN SMITH VOTING NO.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILWOMAN LARSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN SCHULTZ THAT THERE ARE NO ATV/UTV'S ALLOWED ON TOWER LANE WITH THE UNDERSTANDING IT IS BECAUSE THERE ARE NO HOUSE ADDRESSES ON THAT STREET AND THERE WILL BE PROPER SIGNAGE. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN RUD AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN SCHULTZ TO APPROVE AND ADOPT RESOLUTION #R16-07-03 OF COMMENDATION OF DAVID W. HOLDEN. MOTION CARRIED WITH COUNCILWOMAN SMITH ABSTAINING AND COUNCILMAN KRISIK VOTING NO.

A PICTURE OF THE OVER FLOWING CLOTHING BOX LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY OF SCHAFER PROPERTIES ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE CITY WAS SHARED.
