

Call to Order:

Meeting called to order at 6:35 P.M. by Mayor Pronschinske, presiding over the meeting at City Hall Council Chambers, 156 S. Franklin St., Mondovi, WI

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

Accept Agenda:

Motion by Schultz, seconded by Krisik to approve agenda as posted. Motion carried on roll call 6-0.

Citizen's Comments:

Galen Aase- Concern regarding side of street for sidewalk project on W. Mill St.

(Audrey Aase, Janice Mikelson, Duane Brantner, and Paulene Johnson all shared the same concern)

Greg Corning, School District Administrator- Questions the need and priority of a sidewalk on the north side of W. Mill St. and the financial burden it brings to the school district for the special assessment.

Connie Matchey- Concerns regarding a sidewalk on north side of W. Mill St.

Old Business:

Joy Kellner- spoke regarding her request for the City to remove a tree in the right-of-way on her property at 556 W. Water St. for reasons that the branches touch her power lines in the wind causing her lights to flicker and concerns with roots in her sewer line.

Teresa Schofield- also shared concerns the tree brings to Joy Kellner.

Lori Falkner- spoke of a tree she recently took down in the City right-of-way on her property and questioned the City reimbursement for the cost of it if the City decides to remove trees in the right-of-way for other property owners.

1. Motion by Smith, seconded by Avery that the City does not remove the tree at 556 W. Water St., mainly because even though it is in the city right-of-way, we don't have proof it was planted by the City, it's not a hazard according to Xcel Energy, and there are too many other trees (in the City) within the 15 foot of the street that everybody could come to ask the City to be responsible to remove their tree. Motion carried by roll call 4-2. Avery-yes, Erickson-yes, Krisik-yes, Rud-no, Schultz-no, Smith-yes.

2. Smith gave an update on the Christopher Reeves Grant application budget. No motion.

3. Motion by Avery, second by Krisik to move forward with the special assessment project (sidewalk on the north side of W. Mill Street from the school to N. Harrison St.) allocating 50% of the \$50,837.50 cost to the School District of Mondovi and the remaining 50% of the cost to the City (\$25,418.75 each). Motion carried by roll call 4-2. Avery-yes, Erickson-yes, Krisik-yes, Rud-no, Schultz-no, Smith-yes.

Committee Reports:

1. Motion by Smith, seconded by Krisik to Accept Finance Report of September 12, 2016 and Approval of vouchers payable. Disbursement identification of check #41731-#41814, manual check #2060803-#20160806, and #20160901 totaling \$124,842.99, also with the additions of ck#41815-#41819 for \$1768.01 for a grand total of \$126,611.00. Motion carried by roll call 6-0.
2. Motion by Krisik, seconded by Schultz to Approve Special Council Meeting Minutes of August 30, 2016. Motion carried by roll call 6-0.

New Business:

Motion by Rud, seconded by Krisik to confirm the appointment of Fred Weber, Weber Inspections, as the City of Mondovi building inspector of new residential one and two family dwellings, additions, and decks. Motion amended by Rud, seconded by Avery to include inspections of City residential rehabilitation projects. Motion carried by roll call 6-0.
2. Discussion on the future Prevea Clinic at 250 State Hwy 37, Mondovi.
3. Motion by Krisik, seconded by Schultz to Approve and Adopt Ordinance #O-16-09-01 to Amend and Recreate Subsection (d) under “Chapter 18. Zoning and Planning-SECTION 18.01 ZONING”, Subsection (54) “Enforcement, Violation, and Penalties.” Motion carried by roll call 6-0.
