Declaration of Instruction: COVID-19 City of Mondovi

In a forward effort to contain and mitigate the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), the following directives shall be immediately implemented to protect and preserve the health, safety and well-being of our citizens with special attention to older adults and people who have serious chronic medical conditions.

All facilities open to the public within the City of Mondovi in addition to Federal, State and Local regulations already in place SHALL observe the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) established guidelines at a minimum and adhere to the following directives.

- *Frequently disinfect high human traffic areas, including but not limited to tables, chairs, benches, stools, countertops, bars, service desks, and bank teller counters. Furthermore, disinfectant shall be applied on entrance and exit doors, handles, gas pumps, ATMs and card readers.*
- *Maintain an adequate amount of hygiene products in restrooms at all times.*
- *Provide proper personal protective equipment (PPE) for individuals applying disinfectant, cleaners and in contact with potentially infected areas.*

Citizens SHOULD follow best practices pertaining to Public Health during this pandemic.

- *Wash your hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds.*
- *Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.*
- *Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze.*
- *Stay home if you are sick.*
- *Be prepared with enough supplies including food, medicine, cleaning supplies and personal care items in the event you would need to self-quarantine.*
- *Consider avoiding large crowds and events.*
- *Maintain distance between people including not shaking hands (social distancing).*
- *Assisted living facilities should limit access to their elderly residents and those with underlying health conditions to only necessary visitors, guests and service providers. Following directions from facility managers;*
- *report a positive test for the Coronavirus (COVID-19) to the Buffalo County Health and Human Services Department.*

The before mentioned instructions shall be effective immediately and will remain in effect for a minimum of 30 days or until conditions no longer warrant. I am requesting voluntary compliance as soon as possible to avoid other enforcement measures.

These measures are critical to the prevention of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and could potentially save lives, especially those most vulnerable in our community.

Thank you for your attention to this serious matter. Through our collective efforts, we will ensure Mondovi continues to be a safe place to work and live during these challenging times.
